

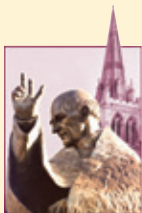

### Visualising Spirit: Wings for Chichester Cathedral by Carrie Fertig



An extraordinary pair of frameworked glass dove wings – comprised of individual glass feathers – suspended above visitors in the North Transept of the

Cathedral. The individual feathers are frameworked glass and each feather ranges from 33 – 105cm in length. This beautiful installation forms a 25ft pair of dove wings, at a scale intended for flight for the human body. Open every day with free entry.

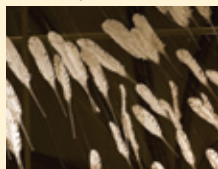

An extraordinary pair of 25 ft glass dove wings will be suspended above visitors in the Cathedral's North Transept. Altogether, and outstretched, the dove wings are at a scale intended for flight for the human body. Each individual feather ranges from 33cm to 105cm in length and each has been sandblasted on one side to both catch and transmit light.

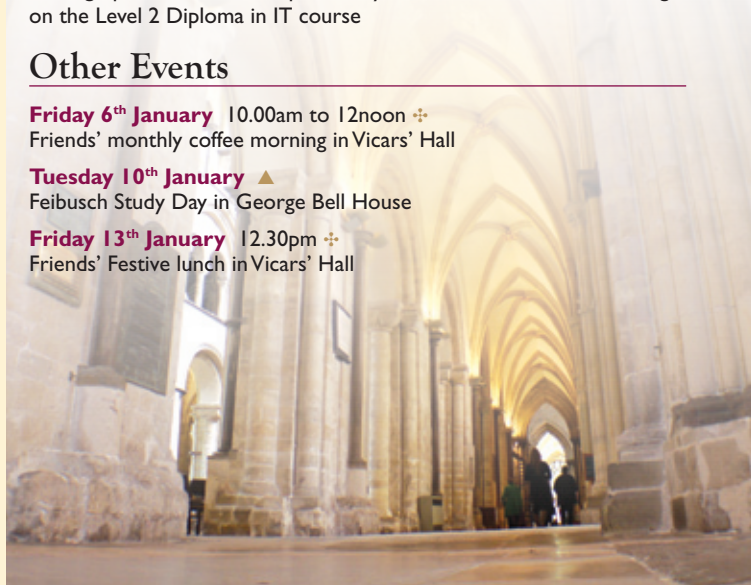
