How to Enter:

The Competition will be announced on Chichester Cathedral's Instagram, Facebook, TikTok and X pages on Monday 2 October 2023.

To enter, participants must follow these steps:

- Post your original photograph or video on your own Instagram, Facebook, TikTok or X account.
- Use the hashtag #PeaceDovesChichester.
- Tag us in your post.
- Ensure your post is set to public so that it is viewable to the judging panel.

Entry Rules:

- Photographs and video must be the participant's original work.
- Only one entry per person is allowed.
- Entries containing offensive, inappropriate, or copyrighted material will be disqualified.
- By entering the Competition, participants grant Chichester Cathedral the right to use, display, and share their submitted photographs/video on social media, website, and promotional materials with proper attribution.

- Entries will be judged based on creativity, composition, and adherence to the theme.
