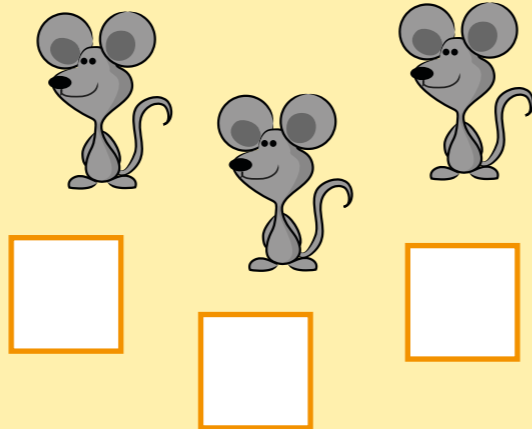

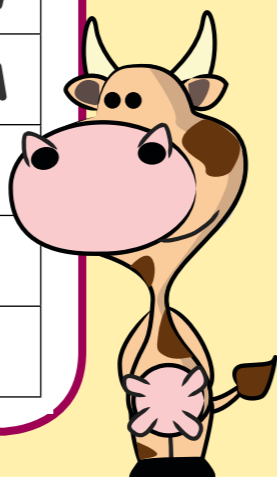

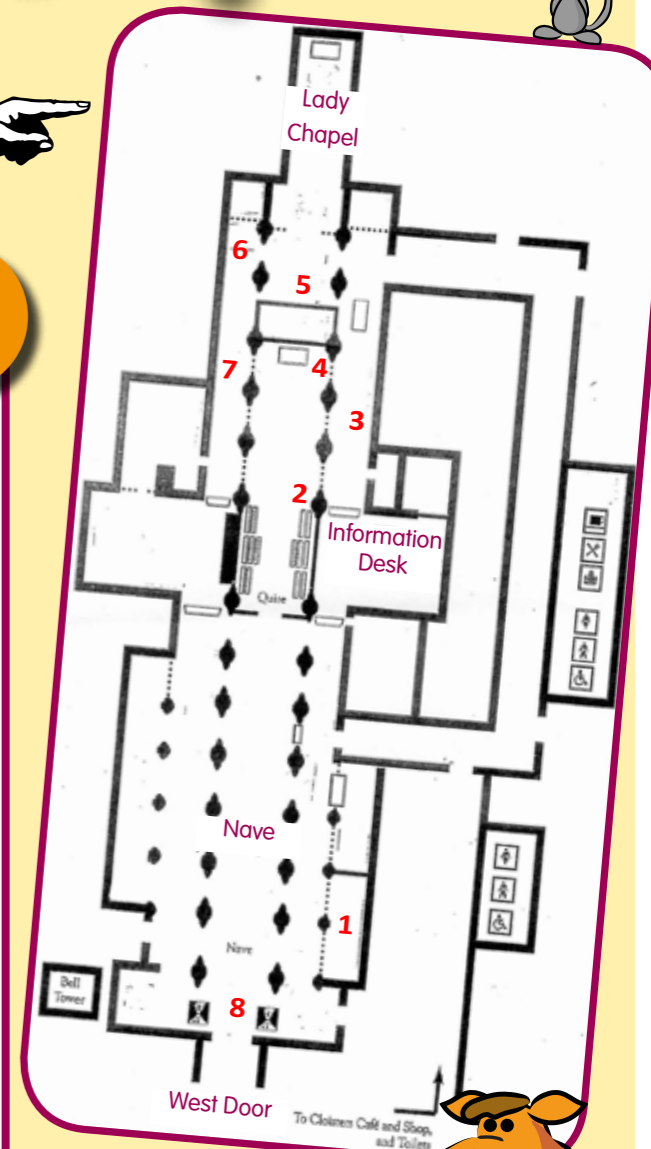
Use the map to help you find the Cathedral's hidden mini mice and meet some of their animal FRIENDS.
