Chichester Cathedral site capacity:

Capacity for specific areas of Cathedral:

Worship:

Nave: 65 pax
North Aisle: 12 pax
South Aisle: 21 pax
North Chapel / 'VIDA': 25 pax
Quire Stalls: 30 pax
Lady Chapel: 12 pax

Seating patterns: Seating in Nave laid out at 2m distancing. Couples and family/support bubbles to sit apart to reduce transmission risk.

Lady Chapel and Quire seating reduced in order to facilitate distance.

Prayer/Reflection:

Capacity for whole building: 200 pax

(NB: North Transept and Treasury currently closed to the public)

Capacity measured by visitor counter at West door and monitored by staff onsite. The West door is the exclusive entrance to the public(excluding accessible means). Capacity measured at 10m² per person on site.

Singing and performing:

Where singing or chanting is essential to an act of worship, this should be limited to one person wherever possible. Exceptionally, where it is essential to the service, up to three individuals should be permitted to do so. Strict social distancing is observed, singers to be separated by two (2) metre of distancing.

Communal (congregational) singing will not take place. This applies even if social distancing is being observed or face coverings are used, indoors and outdoors.
