

CHICHESTER CATHEDRAL

Chichester's magnificent 900 year old Cathedral is a living Church standing at the heart of the city, its spire dominating the horizon for miles around. It is Mother Church to the parishes of Sussex and welcomes visitors of any faith and those with none. With history, heritage, art and music – and the beautiful Bishop's Palace Gardens to explore - it's a must-see for visitors of all ages.

Open every day and all year, there is no charge for entry. Free guided tours for small groups run at 11.15am and 2.30pm from Monday to Saturday – tours last about an hour and there's no need to book. There are a number of special trails for children. The Cloisters Café offers delicious homemade food from breakfast to afternoon tea, light snacks and indulgent lunches.

In this leaflet you will find details of all our special events and services until the end of March. You are also very welcome to drop in and join one of the daily services, or just wander freely.




