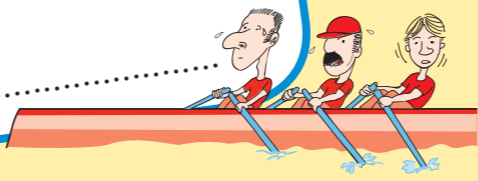
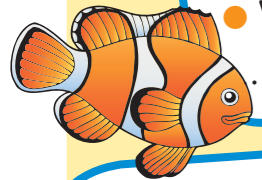

- Draw the sails on these ships.

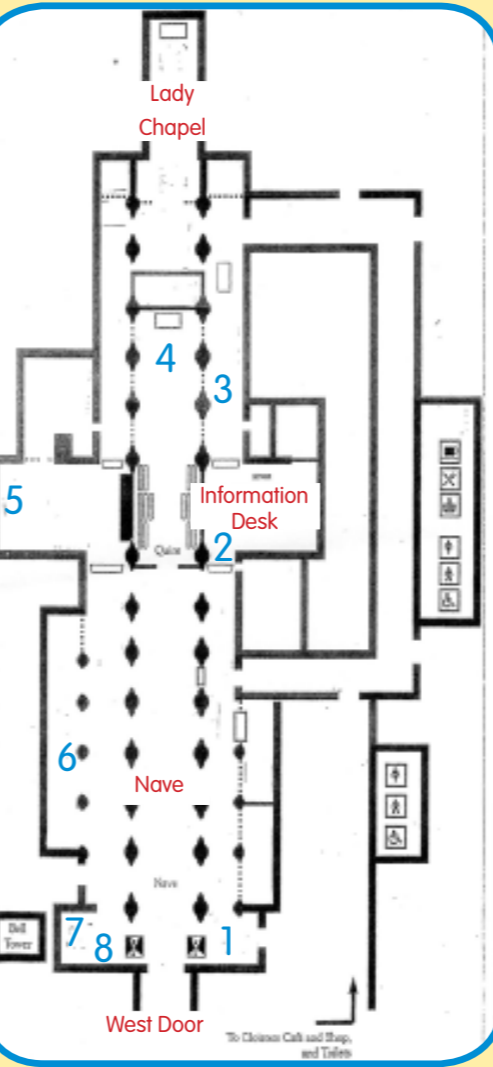

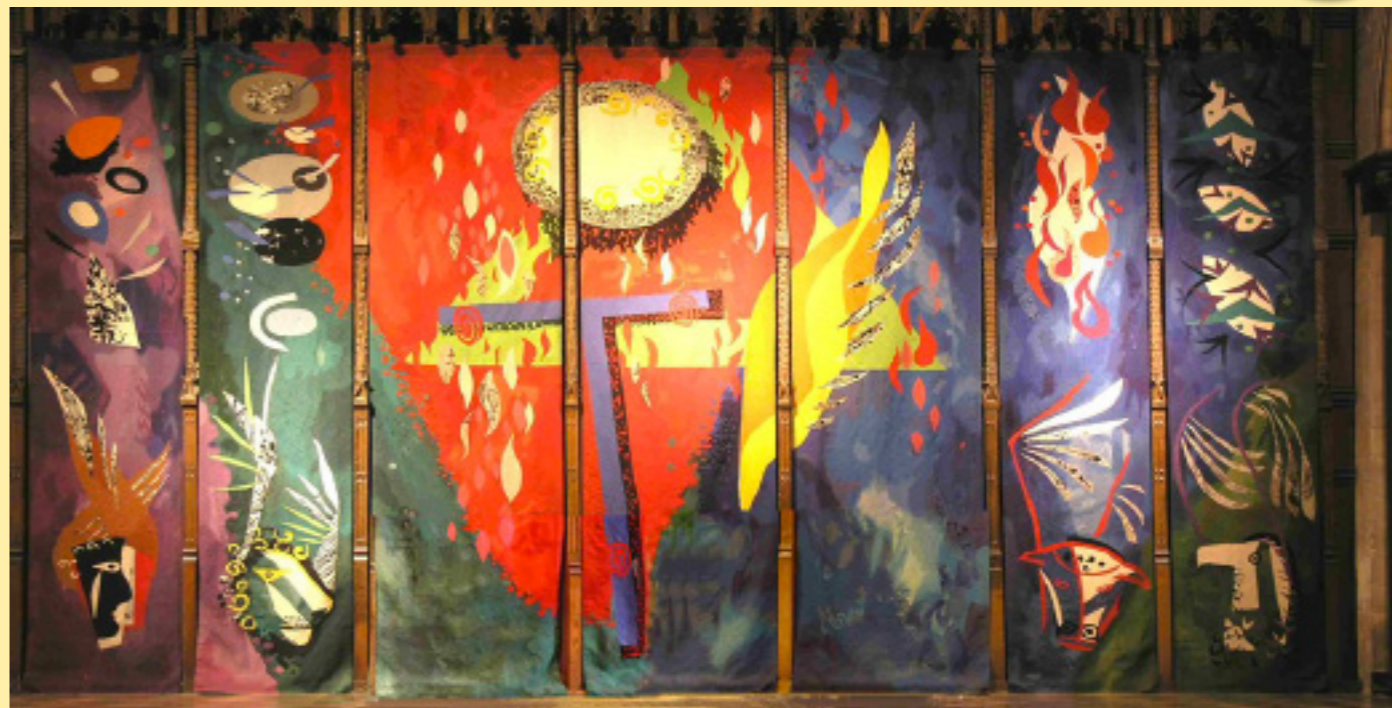
The picture by FEIBUSCH shows the baptism of Jesus.
